Busted with Cocaine in San Leon:

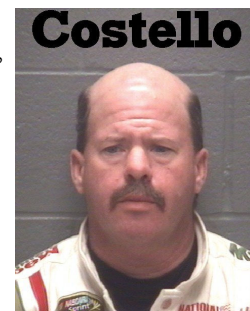
